- **Pen Drawing w/ Alexia Carvalho – Tuesdays & Thursdays, 2:30-4:30 p.m. - \$20**
Students will use pens – black & white and color – to make postcards, bookmarks, coasters, and holiday gifts incorporating Zentangle structured pattern designs. Learn about drawing and composition as well as storytelling!
- **Intermediate Sewing w/ Iris Thompson - Fridays, 2:30-5 p.m. - \$10**
Students will undertake more advanced projects, making items using sewing machines as well as hand work. Most materials will be provided but students/families may bring preferred cotton fabrics for class projects. Both boys and girls welcome. Will focus on holiday gifts and related projects. If student is unsure of whether he/she is ready for an Intermediate or Advanced class, see Auntie Bernie in the office.
- **Advanced Sewing w/ Iris Thompson - Thursdays, 2:30-5 p.m. - \$10**
Students will undertake more advanced projects. Most materials will be provided but students/families may bring their own cotton fabrics. Both boys and girls welcome. Will focus on holiday gifts and related projects. If student is unsure of whether he/she is ready for an Intermediate or Advanced class, see Auntie Bernie in the office.
- **Sports 101 w/ Devven Presley – Mondays & Fridays – 2:30-4 p.m. & Wednesdays – 1:30-3 p.m. - \$20**
A combination of learning about different sports plus basic conditioning to include strength, endurance, agility, speed, etc. Will cover proper movement techniques and what to do and use to develop certain athletic qualities to apply to sports later in life. First 2 weeks will focus on basketball for a game with Honokaa after school Thurs., Nov. 2, 2017 in Thelma Parker Gym. Important to come to class ready to work out and have fun!
- **After-School Science Investigations w/ Matt Binder – Mondays & Fridays, 2:30-4 p.m. - \$20**
Students will learn to think like a scientist and, in the process, discover that science is fascinating and fun! Mr. Binder will use his big bag of scientific tricks to help students answer all sorts of questions about science -- from astronomy to zoology, biology to chemistry, and geology to physics.
