- ❖ **Pen Drawing w/ Alexia Carvalho – Tuesday, 2:30-4 p.m. - \$10**
Pen and pencil still life drawing, including different shapes to create a 3D image. Final will be a framed piece to hang on a wall.
- ❖ **Painting w/ Alexia Carvalho – Thursday, 2:30-4 p.m. - \$10**
Painting with watercolor and acrylic mediums alone and combined. Students will be painting on canvas as well as other items like mugs and lamp shades. Classes will be using artistic license to use what the artist needs to express themselves in their individual pieces.
- ❖ **Mural Art w/Alexia Carvalho – Wednesday, 1:30-3:30 p.m. \$ 10**
Come help make our campus even more beautiful and in the process, share a story, legend or core value! Learn about drawing, composition, color development and painting.
- ❖ **Introductory & Advanced Sewing w/ Iris Thompson - Thursdays, 2:30-5 p.m. - \$10**
Learn to sew and how to use a sewing machine for beginning sewing classes. For Advanced sewing, you will be applying the skills learned in beginning, intermediate, and advanced classes, and also learn to read and understand how to sew while using a pattern.
- ❖ **Coding w/ Erica Owens – Every other Monday – 2:30-4 p.m. & Wednesdays – 1:15-2 p.m. - \$20**
Students will be learning how to write codes to program the computer to create art designs. Students will also learn how to write codes to help Moana accomplish tasks and help Angry Birds get the pigs.
- ❖ **After-School Science Investigations w/ Matt Binder – Mondays & Fridays, 2:30-4 p.m. - \$20**
Students will learn to think like a scientist and, in the process, discover that science is fascinating and fun! Mr. Binder will use his big bag of scientific tricks to help students answer all sorts of questions about science -- from astronomy to zoology, biology to chemistry, and geology to physics. Class open to Grades 5-8.
- ❖ **Bucket Drumming w/Jordan Lopez, - Tuesday, 2:30-4 p.m. - \$10**
Learn basic drumming beats using buckets. Sing along with music and learn the basic skills of singing.
- ❖ **Photography w/ Bob Fewell – Wednesdays 1:30 – 3 p.m. - \$ 10**
Students will learn how to take better photographs by developing “visual awareness”, the ability to see the world through the eyes of a photographer. Students are invited to use their own personal cameras and will be shown how to operate them for the creative control of images. iPad cameras will be provided to students that do not own a camera.
