❖ **Beginner Stitch w/Erica Owens – Mondays, 2:30-3:30 p.m. \$10**

Students will make projects that integrate textiles, circuits and coding. Some projects are paper circuits, a bracelet that lights up. **Grades 5-8**

❖ **Advanced Stitch w/ Tina Yohon – Mondays, 2:30-3:30 p.m. \$10**

Students will be continue to make projects that integrate textiles, circuits and coding. Some projects are a bracelet that lights up and a lunch bag that senses temperature changes. **Grades 5-8**

❖ **Fluid Art w/ Sharon Petrosky – Mondays, 2:30–4:30 p.m. \$10**

Students can have fun with this class as they create abstract paintings using the fluid painting technique. When done painting they will write a reflection of what they see in their art. **Grades 4-8 only three spaces available for WMS.**

❖ **After-School Science Investigations w/ Matt Binder – Mondays & Fridays, 2:30-4 p.m. \$20**

Students will learn to think like a scientist and, in the process, discover that science is fascinating and fun! Mr. Binder will use his big bag of scientific tricks to help students answer all sorts of questions about science from astronomy to zoology, biology to chemistry, and geology to physics. **Grades 5-8**

Students will learn about music, beat, harmony, melody, rhythm and tempo. **Grades 3-8**

❖ **Okinawan Style Taiko Drumming w/ Lisa Hallett – Tuesdays, 2:30-4:00 p.m. \$10**

We carry our drums, perform to music, shout & jump around. Students will also learn about the history and culture of Okinawa. **Grades 3-8**

❖ **Capoeira w/ Mario Hill – Thursdays, 3:00-4 p.m. \$10**
