Strength and Math, Grades: K, Ms. Hilda, Develop basic physical strength & mobility and math skills while participating in obstacle courses

HAWAIIAN PLANTS: Lisa Hallett, Grades: Kids will learn how to plant native plants organically. We will be learning about planting, preparing and cooking. Planting for eating, and other uses like Art. Children will be bringing home plants in pots. Boxes will be provided for transport.

STICH, Grades 5-8, Tina Yohon, Students will make projects that integrate, circuits and coding, some projects are paper circuits, a bracelet that lights up and a lunch bag that senses temperature.
