- ❖ **Coding w/ Erica Owens – Mondays, 2:30-4 p.m. \$10**
Students will be learning how to write codes to program the computer to create art designs. Students will also learn how to write codes to help Moana accomplish tasks and help Angry Birds get the pigs. **Grades 5-8**

- ❖ **After-School Science Investigations w/ Matt Binder – Mondays & Fridays, 2:30-4 p.m. \$20**
Students will learn to think like a scientist and, in the process, discover that science is fascinating and fun! Mr. Binder will use his big bag of scientific tricks to help students answer all sorts of questions about science from astronomy to zoology, biology to chemistry, and geology to physics. **Grades 5-8**

- ❖ **Usable Art w/ Alexia Carvalho – Tuesdays, 2:30-4 p.m. \$10**
